


## VOLUNTEER

## NOWRUZ FESTIVAL

The Iranian Cultural Foundation hosts the Nowruz festival in Houston every year, and 2025 marked our 16th annual event. As our biggest fundraising effort of the year, the proceeds from this festival play a crucial role in funding ICF's activities and supporting our mission throughout the year. Nowruz 2025 was a tremendous success, making history as our most profitable festival to date, with sponsorships being the top source of revenue.



We had over 2,500 attendees at the Nowruz Festival.
Additionally, the City of Houston issued a Nowruz Day proclamation, presented by the Harris County Sheriff's department on behalf of Mayor John Whitmire.



## DIDARE DOUSTAN

Didare Doustan, or Meeting of Friends, is a warm and welcoming gathering held on the last Friday of each month. Members come together to sing and play music, discuss a wide range of topics such as ancient Iranian religions, scientific and medical news, and recite the poetry of Hafez and Molavi. Mrs. Nahid Sabeti, the group's director, offers practical insights in psychology and occasionally leads the group in a brief meditation.

The program concludes with participants sharing a homemade potluck lunch, fostering a sense of community. This gathering has a positive and profound effect on the spirit of the participants, who eagerly look forward to reuniting the following month.






## SHAHNAME KHANI

## ICF SCHOOL

At the Iranian Cultural Foundation Houston, our Sunday School is our pride and joy. We offer Persian (Farsi) classes from Kindergarten through 5th grade, along with a variety of other enriching programs such as conversational Persian, conversational English, Persian dance, art, storytelling, calligraphy, theater and more.

Our students have the opportunity to showcase their talents by performing songs and dances on stage at our annual Nowruz festival. Through our Sunday School, we are dedicated to nurturing a love for Iranian culture, language, and the arts in the next generation.

We're proud to report that the school saw a 31% increase in net revenue and a 39% increase in total student enrollment year over year.

Museum's longest-running film festival.


In its 32nd year, the festival took place from January 24–31, 2025, showcasing a remarkable lineup of films celebrating Iranian cinema.








Over the course of the past year, ICF worked hard to increase our assets.








## 2025 NOWRUZ FESTIVAL

#### Revenues




Sponsorships \$64,500 The 2025 Nowruz

#### Expenses




## REVENUE AT A GLANCE



In 2025, our two largest revenue sources were the ICF School (43%) and the Nowruz Festival (42%), together making up 85% of total revenue.




## **EXPENSES AT A GLANCE**
