Rules & Terms for Participation

1. Prohibited Items

Vendors may not sell tobacco products, alcohol, firearms, or home cooked food.

2. Booth Location

Bazaar tables will be provided either in a covered outdoor space or indoors, depending on availability.

3. Advertising & Promotion

Promotion at your table must be limited to the business named in this contract. Advertising for additional businesses or events is NOT permitted without prior written authorization from ICF-Houston.

4. Clean-Up

Vendors are responsible for keeping their table area clean throughout the festival and for leaving it in good condition at the end of the event.

5. Set-Up Period

Vendors may begin setting up between 12:00 PM - 2:00 PM. Please be ready to welcome guests when the festival begins.

6. Teardown Period

Teardown may begin at 8:00 PM and must be completed by 10:00 PM

7. Food Vendor Requirements

All food vendors must provide a copy of their valid Food Permit and Certificate of Liability Insurance prior to the event.
